## CALL FOR EMAIL NOMINATIONS

### **R. Duncan Luce Outstanding Paper Award (2018)**

The Society for Mathematical Psychology presents an award annually for the most outstanding paper published in the *Journal of Mathematical Psychology* in the preceding three years. The award is named after R. Duncan Luce, recognizing his founding role in the field of mathematical psychology, and in our Society and the journal.

For the 2018 award, publications dated 2015 - 2018 will be considered.

Nominations should include exact title, authors, and publication date in the *Journal of Mathematical Psychology*.

The authors nominated need not be members of the Society. Self-nominations will not be considered.

The winner will be selected by a special committee appointed by the Editor of the *Journal of Mathematical Psychology*; the selection committee normally is chaired by the *Journal of Mathematical Psychology* Editor-in-Chief. The winner will be announced at the 51<sup>st</sup> Annual Mathematical Psychology Society Meeting in 2018.
